The RAG rating was assigned as follows:

- Green areas are predicted to achieve over 5 biodiversity units per hectare/kilometre and have the highest potential for BNG uplift.
- Amber areas are predicted to achieve between 2 to 5 biodiversity units per hectare/kilometre and have moderate potential for BNG uplift.
- Red areas are predicted to achieve under 2 biodiversity units per hectare/kilometre and have the lowest potential for BNG uplift.

No red areas are shown on the map. A red rating would only apply if floodplain grazing marsh is created within cropland. As creating other neutral grassland within cropland has the highest potential for BNG uplift this is what has been mapped.

Area-based terrestrial habitats are mapped only. Hedgerows and watercourses are not included as this was beyond the scope of this assessment.
