



Attendance update - Access and Inclusion Service

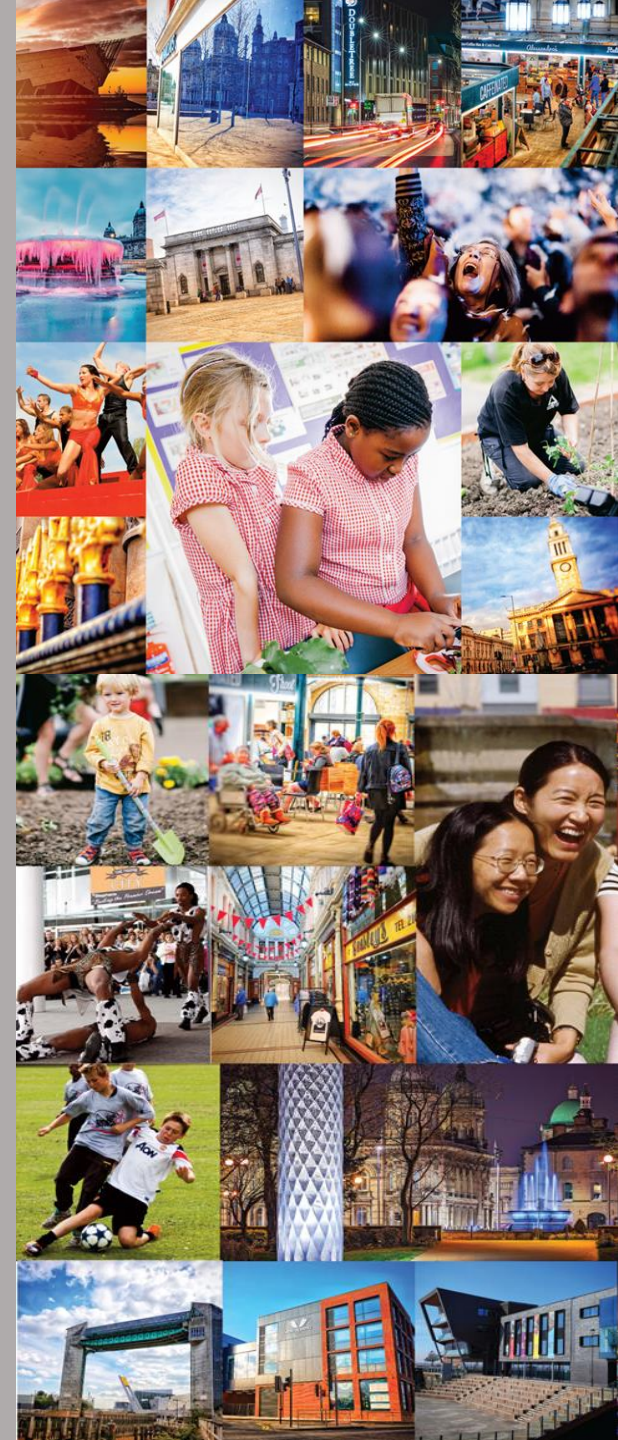
The North has some of the best performing schools in the city!

The national average for attendance is 91.4%

Secondary

St Mary's College exceeds this with 94.4%, closely followed by Kingswood Academy at 93.8%

The lowest performing secondary school in terms of attendance in the North is Sirius Academy North with 88.1%



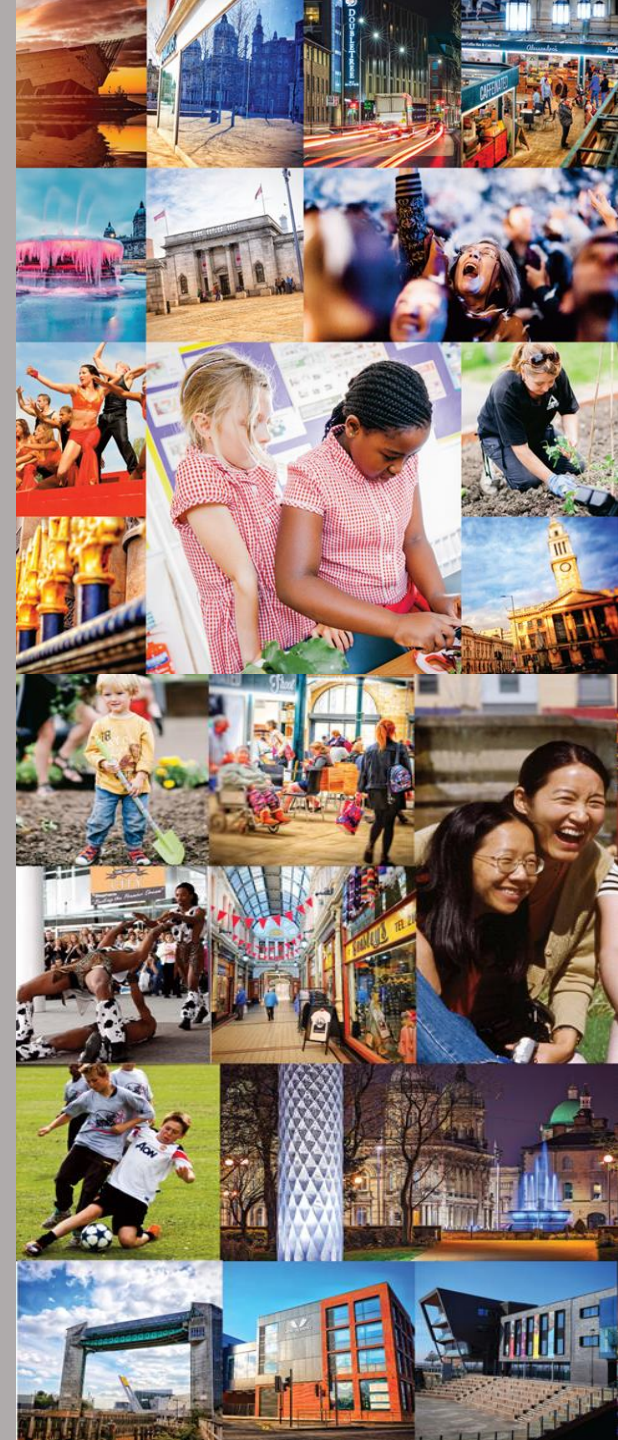
Sharing best practice/strategies applied

exclusion data is tracked.



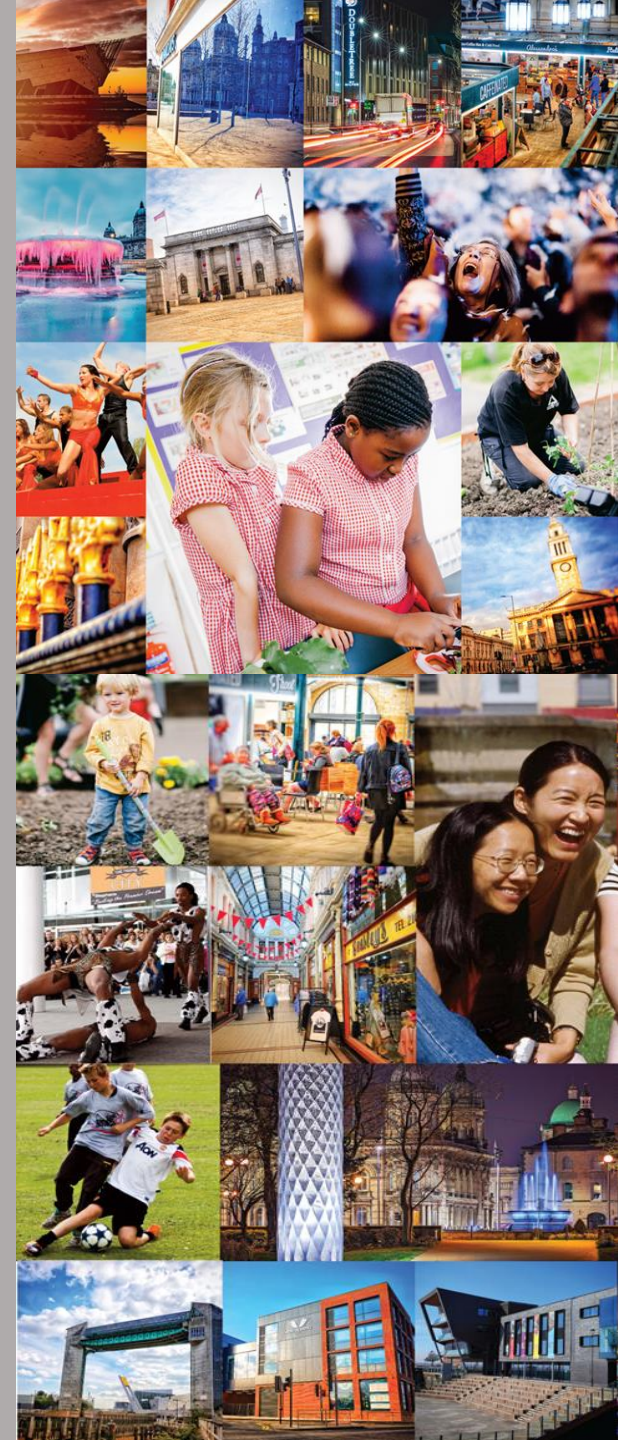
Parent engagement

A pupil is considered persistently absent if they miss 10% or more of their possible school sessions. This includes both authorised and unauthorised absences.

(A pupil is classified as a severe absentee if they miss 50% or more of their possible school sessions.)
