**Notes** (Joint Authorities and Joint Committees):-

1. Under proportionality rules contained with the Local Government and Housing Act, 1989:-
  - (a) Proportionality is applied to the number of seats available on each individual committee.
  - (b) There is no aggregation of the total number of seats available – this only applies to Council Committees.
  - (c) The majority group should form the majority on each committee.
2. The allocation of seats requires the rounding up or down of calculated figures to give whole numbers.
3. The calculations for proportionality are based upon the Committees as they stand as of today and it should be noted that if members seek to change then this may affect the calculation.
