18.	CRIME PREVENTION FUND APPLICATONS (This item was considered in conjunction with minute 20.) (Councillor Dolman declared an interest in the item that follows below insofar as he was a ward councillor for Kingswood ward (application CPF31-03)). The Director of Legal Services and Partnerships submitted a report which set out the applications received for Crime Prevention funding. The options available were (i) agree to provide funding for the application(s), (ii) not agree to provide funding for the application(s) and (iii) request further details or actions prior to determining some or all of the applications.	

	<p>Agreed –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. That up to £10,150 be allocated to the East Area Neighbourhood Team, Marfleet Ward for the installation of a boundary bund wall at Stonebridge Playing Fields (CPF30-06); b. That application (CPF31-01) be deferred until the additional information including quotes for the purchase of equipment is provided; c. That up to £3,726.90 be allocated to Marfleet Family Hub for the installation of an external pram park (CPF31-02); d. That up to £24,000 be allocated to Humberside Police, North Neighbourhood Policing Team for target hardening equipment in the Kingswood Ward (CPF31-03); e. That up to £17,825.50 be allocated to West Area Team, (Newington & Gypsyville Ward) for the purchase of two CCTV cameras, plus wireless kit with 4 stations (CPF31-04) and that feedback is provided on the impact on crime in the area to include any relevant environmental crime statistics, and f. That up to £8,000 is allocated to One Punch Hull for the purchase of equipment for the charity’s new premises (CPF31-05). <p><u>Reasons for Recommendations</u> The sub-committee are satisfied that the approved applications are capital schemes which will help reduce crime and allow residents to feel safe.</p>
