**Education, Employment and Training (Room 42 Link Up)** - Our champions are busy working with people in the council and with local businesses to develop opportunities for young people to move towards employment. We work closely with the Employment Hub and have helped lots of young people start their journey to success.

**Consultation** - Groups meet to talk about their experiences and have their voices heard. Young people can influence the services and support offered to care Leavers from Hull and even get involved in the National Young Peoples Benchmarking Forum (YPBMF).
